- Real estate tax statement/tax card/tax bill
- Settlement statement on refinanced or purchased property (HUD1)
- Schedule of estimated taxes (federal & state) amount & date paid
- Child care name of provider, identification number & amount paid
- Dependents social security number, date of birth
- 1095-A, 1095-B, 1095-C and Insurance card for proof of insurance for NJ
- K-1's from partnership, S Corporation interest
- 1098 T Tuition payment statement
- W-2 G Certain gambling winnings
- Medical expenses (whether or not itemizing May use in NJ)
- Charitable contributions (if itemizing)
- 1098 Mortgage interest statement
- Rental income and expenses
- Alimony payments or receipts
- Jury pay
- Sales tax for large ticket items such as an automobile or boat
- Form 1099 SSA Social Security Benefits
- Receipts for classroom materials (for teachers)
- BITCOIN (CRYPTOCURRENCY) PURCHASE/SALE INFORMATION

- NJ Sales tax not charged on online or out of state purchases
